



SAFETY COMES FIRST PRACTICE SUPERVISION POLICY

There needs to be organized supervision during indoor and outdoor practices. This is for the safety of all our kids. Parents of each team must provide a parent volunteer during practices who is not a coach. We all want our coaches to focus on coaching, not looking for errant behavior. The following is a list of responsibilities and rules that the parent supervisor must enforce.

- For indoor practices, only the use specific indoor equipment may be used. Care needs to be taken to insure that no outdoor equipment (hard balls, aluminum/wood bats) is brought into the facility. These items need to be returned to the automobile, and may not be kept inside the facility.
- For indoor practices, there is no food or drink allowed in any facility, with the exception of water bottles.
- Parent supervisors need to arrive at the facility 10 minutes before the scheduled activity.
- As players from their team arrive, they must be kept together at a safe distance from any activities that are ongoing, and proceed into facility when a prior teams activities have concluded. No activities should take place until previous teams have cleared the facility.
- During practices, the supervisor should observe all activities taking place and advise the coaches if you see a potential situation where safety is compromised.
- At the conclusion of their team's activities, they motivate the team's cooperation in vacating the facility. Personal belongings, as well as any trash, need to be cleared away.
- Make sure no child is left behind alone and that they don't scatter without their own parent's approval. (If a parent is habitually late in picking up their child, please inform the Commissioner).

The result of any non-compliance with these policies will result in removal of that team's facility use privileges for that season.
